- Courts open for practice
- Long Toss Contest ticket sales open Chance to Win \$5,000 cash!

2:30 pm WELCOME / RULES

2:45 pm TOURNAMENT STARTS

- Teams report to Starting Courts for Qualifying Rounds
- Consists of four games per team, scoring based on total points
- Each team will have three rounds of tosses (twelve tosses per person per game)

4:45 pm LONG TOSS CONTEST WIN \$5,000 CASH!

- Closest to the hole wins \$500!
- Must be present to win!

TOURNAMENT RULES

GAME PLAY

All eight cornhole bags begin at one end of the board (four blue, four yellow). A coin flip determines which cornhole team has honors in round one. The team with honors tosses first.

A cornhole player may throw from anywhere behind the front of the cornhole board (on the side they are throwing from). Alternate throws between the two opponents until all eight cornhole bags have been thrown.

QUALIFYING ROUND

Consists of four (4) games and the score will be kept by **total points**. Each team will have three rounds of tosses (twelve tosses per person, per game).

Teams will record their own scores for this round. Return your scorecards to a volunteer in a yellow lanyard.

The top point scoring teams from each pool advance.

Do NOT cancel points. You are recording the total points as the teams with the highest point totals advance to bracket play.

SWEET SIXTEEN

Eight teams advance (play to 15 points). Do not cancel points.

ELITE EIGHT

Four teams advance (play to 15 points). *Do not cancel points.*

FINAL FOUR

Two teams advance to the Championship Round (play to 21 points). Remaining two teams play for third and fourth place. *Do not cancel points.*

CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND

The first team to score 21 points wins the tournament (must win by two points).

POINT SYSTEM



3-Points — Hole-in-One

Cornhole bag that goes through the hole



1-Point — Cliff Hanger

Cornhole bag that actually hangs into the hole



1-Point — Close, but No Cigar

Cornhole bag that is on the playing surface



1-Point — Hanging by a Thread

Cornhole bag that hangs off the edge, but does not touch the ground



O-Points — Straddling the Fence

Cornhole bag that is on the playing surface, but is also touching the ground



0-Points — No Piggy Backing

Cornhole bag that hangs off the front edge and is resting on a cornhole bag that is on the ground

O-Points — **The Skipper** Cornhole bag that bounces, then lands on the board

WILL NOT count for any points and is considered dead. It must be removed before the next bag is thrown.

Cornhole Fouls

If a cornhole player's foot goes past the foot-foul line (the front of the cornhole board) they will be given a warning. Any future foot-fouls will result in a foul and the bag will be removed from play.

If a player goes out of turn, the throw (foul) is voided (if the bag is on the board, remove it)
